Call for nomination: the APA Award for distinguished scientists.

The Asian and Oceanian Photochemistry Association (APA) recognizes distinguished scientists by creating the APA Award.

The following are the guidelines for the APA Award and a list of requirements for the nomination.

1. The APA recognizes scientist's contribution to the photo-sciences and his/her influence on the field in the Asian and Oceanian area through recommendation by others.
2. The number of the prizewinner should be a maximum of two within a period of two years.
3. The criteria for the review process would be the contribution and scientific influence by the candidate on the photo-science in the Asian and Oceanian areas.
4. The person recommending the candidate should submit a signed application form (**APA-A-1**) by **airmail**, in which 30 selected papers of the candidate are listed, with an unsigned copy of the form (pdf) and copies of 10 selected papers in pdf taken from the list by **e-mail**, to the APA office. The e-mail should be designated with indication of "APA-2018" on its title (subject).
5. The APA councilors will be the reviewers for the award and the prizewinners shall be decided by a vote among the APA Councilors.
6. Schedule for the APA Award.
 - June, 2018: Announcement and call for nominations for the award.
 - July 20, 2018: **Deadline for nominations.**
 - August, 2018: Decision of the prizewinners.
 - December 16-20, 2018: The prizewinners shall be awarded at the 10th APC-2018 held in Taipei (<http://apc2018.conf.tw/site/page.aspx?pid=901&sid=1200&lang=en>)
