

## *APA-Award for “Distinguished Achievement to APA” 2018*

### **Call for nomination: the APA Award for “Distinguished Achievements to APA”.**

The Asian and Oceanian Photochemistry Association (APA) recognizes contributors by creating the APA Award for “Distinguished Achievements to APA”.

The following are the guidelines for the APA Award for “Distinguished Achievements to APA” and a list of requirements for the nomination.

1. The APA recognizes scientist’s contribution to the distinguished achievements to APA in the Asian and Oceanian area through recommendation by others.
2. The number of the prizewinner should be a maximum of two within a period of two years.
3. The criteria for the review process would be the contribution to the distinguished achievements to APA by the candidate in the Asian and Oceanian areas.
4. The person recommending the candidate should submit a signed application form (**APA-D-1**) by **airmail** with an unsigned copy of the form (pdf) by e-mail to the APA Secretary office. The e-mail should be designated with indication of “**APA-DA2018**” on its title (subject).
5. The APA councilors will be the reviewers for the award and the prizewinners shall be decided by a vote among the APA Councilors.
6. Schedule for the APA Award for “Distinguished Achievements to APA”.  
June, 2018: Announcement and call for nominations for the award.  
July 20, 2018: **Deadline for nominations.**  
August, 2018: Decision of the prizewinners.  
December 16-20, 2018: The prizewinners shall be awarded at the 10<sup>th</sup> APC-2018 held in Taipei (<http://apc2018.conf.tw/site/page.aspx?pid=901&sid=1200&lang=en>)
