## Call for nomination: the APA Award for Distinguished Achievements to APA.

The Asian and Oceanian Photochemistry Association (APA) recognizes contributors by creating the APA Award for Distinguished Achievements to APA.

The following are the guidelines for the APA Award for Distinguished Achievements to APA and a list of requirements for the nomination.

- 1. The APA recognizes scientist's contribution to the distinguished achievements to APA in the Asian and Oceanian area through recommendation by others.
- 2. The number of the prizewinner should be a maximum of two within a period of two years.
- 3. The criteria for the review process would be the contribution to the distinguished achievements to APA by the candidate in the Asian and Oceanian areas.
- 4. The person recommending the candidate should submit a scanned application form with sign (APA-D-1) by the upload system (https://asianphotochem.org/award/2024/). The file name should be distinguished with "APA-D2024". The file size should be within 20MB. Application forms (APA-D-1) will be available on the APA website (http://www.asianphotochem.com/).
- 5. The APA councilors will be the reviewers for the award and the prizewinners shall be decided by a vote among the APA Councilors.
- 6. Schedule for the APA Award. <u>April 15, 2024:</u> <u>Announcement and call for applications for the award.</u> <u>June 15, 2024:</u> <u>Deadline for nomination.</u> July 2024: Decision of the prizewinners. <u>The end of 2024 or beginning of 2025</u>: The prizewinners shall be awarded at the APC held in Kerala, India.
